March **The God of Life**

Week 1: Genesis 1-2 is the perfect place to start as we consider the fact that all life grows from the God Who is life eternal.

Week 2: Job 39:1-42:6 exalts the Living God for His majesty and power. It should reorient our minds as we consider our trials and temptations in light of His power and will.

Week 3: John 14 make known the glorious reality that Jesus is the life, but it also shows that God the Father and the Holy Spirit are also beautiful parts of that life. **Matthew 16:16** further proclaims Jesus the Christ to be the Son of the Living God.

Week 4: John 11:1-46 unveils the power of the Living God as well as ties our eternal destinies to His resurrection life.

Week 5: Psalms 42 and 84 describe a proper response to this Living God.

Week 6: John 3 illustrates so beautifully how the death of God actually produces life for His followers.

Week 7: Romans 6 too unpacks the divine mystery that death in Christ produces everlasting life.

Week 8: John 8 reveals the gracious forgiveness of God that offers the Light of Life to all who believe.

Week 9: Romans 9 dives deep into the sovereignty and grace of God, part of which results in the Gentiles being called the sons of the Living God.

Week 10: Romans 5 deals with the results of justification, one of which being that we are saved by His life.
